

Case Study: Repositories

A Fortune-20 corporation had a large intellectual property matter of approximately 150 million pages. All data was sent to elumicor and included in a document repository.

repository data used in a new case

When a related case arose, elumicor was able to query the repository for documents produced in the original case that included specific terms and tags.

This query set was copied to the new, related case.

The documents for the new case were sent straight to production, with no need to review because attorney tagging had been used to cull the data prior to the transfer, and privileged documents were not transferred at all.

There was no need to remove Bates numbers from the documents because elumicor's review tool, CoreView™, always uses original, unstamped images when transferring to a new project. There was no additional charge for the transfer. There was no additional charge for the production.



Altogether, 7,087,924 pages (77,161 documents) were transferred from the repository and produced at no additional charge to the client. This translates to a **direct savings of approximately 47%** of the entire project cost. The indirect cost-savings such as attorney review times, removing Bates numbers, processing time, and recollection of data were undoubtedly much greater.



repository data used again

In another related case, it was known from the beginning that the collection could be used in multiple dockets. Elumicor was able to add documents to the repository with a special identifier that was easily searchable.

In this case, 2,297,835 pages (23,720 documents) were transferred and produced and there was no additional charge to the client. This translates to a **direct savings of 100%** of the entire project cost. As with the case above, the indirect cost savings were undoubtedly much greater.

repository advantages

The corporation has the added advantage of being able to use the repository at any time in the future, and so, has the opportunity to benefit from additional cost savings if these documents are needed in other matters.
